Teen Youth Council Committee **Requirements-**

1. Youth applicants must fill out an application before a membership can be established.
2. Youth must be ages 13-18 years of age.
3. All Members Must turn in a school report card at the time it is issued.
4. Any applicant that has obtained a felony or class (A1) misdemeanor charge in the past 12 months from the time the application is submitted will not be allowed to participate on the Youth committee.
5. Members must provide their own transportation to and from all meetings, Staff is not allowed to provide any transportation to youth.
6. Parents/guardians are responsible for completing the parent/guardian portion of the application before a youth can be considered for membership.
7. Members must attend each meeting when possible.
8. All members must report to the Executive Director (Ms.

Kimya Swann) or Assistant Executive Director (Mrs. Baesha Coppedge) with any concerns and or issues concerning the Teen Youth Council Committee or an absent notification.

9. All Applicants must provide proof of age once an application has been approved.

Acceptable forms of ID: Birth Certificate, School ID, Driver's License, School Transcript or Passport.

10. All Applicants must be currently enrolled in school/educational institute.
